70 the Learning Environment Committee (LMU)

71 *Case responsible: The Election Committee*

72

73 **Purpose:**

74 Elect three representatives to the learning environment committee and four substitutes. The position will
75 accede on 1st of July 2026 and will last for one year.

76

77 **Background:**

78 The learning environment committee shall contribute to a good study and learning environment at the
79 university and ensure that the physical and mental learning and working environment is justifiable based
80 on an overall assessment of students' health, safety, and welfare. The learning environment includes all
81 factors that affect students' well-being, and which are within NMBU's area of responsibility, except for
82 the academic study offer. It also includes student welfare and student-social conditions at the institution.
83 LMU has at least two meetings during the semester, where, among other things, it recommends the use
84 of 3.6 million, which is to be spent on major LMU measures on campus. LMU also adopts the distribution
85 of smaller LMU measures, works with action plans around the learning environment, and follows up on
86 surveys such as. The SHoT survey and the Study Barometer.

87 The students are represented as half of the committee members, four out of eight members. Three of the
88 student representatives are elected by the Student Parliament, and the last representative is from AU.

123 *Case responsible: The Election Committee*

125 **Purpose:**

126 Elect a permanent representative and two substitute representatives to the Research Committee. The
127 position starts on 1st of July 2026 and will last for one year.

128

129 **Background:**

130 The Research Committee is NMBU's highest research policy body and shall provide advice and strategic
131 input to the University Board, Rector and Vice - Rector for Research, in matters concerning research,
132 innovation and dissemination. Typical issues you work with are research infrastructure, researcher
133 education, student-active and student-initiated research, and research publication. The Research
134 Committee has approx. eight meetings evenly distributed throughout the year. In addition, there are
135 usually two seminars a year.

136

137 FU is led by the vice-rector for research and innovation, who is currently Finn-Arne Weltzien, and the
138 secretary is the research director Vitalis Pavlovas. Furthermore, the committee consists of the research
139 leaders / vice-dean for research and innovation for each of the seven faculties, a temporary scientific
140 employee proposed by the vice-rector, two students, two PhD candidates appointed by the doctoral
141 association at NMBU (SoDoc), and one employee in technical and administrative position.

142

143 The position is remunerated, including two hours with AU. In advance.

180 committee and ensuring effective follow-up of its initiatives, the leader will have overall responsibility
181 for planning and executing Green Week each spring, an important event that focuses on sustainability at
182 the university through various activities. Furthermore, the leader will be responsible for communicating
183 with relevant partners. The leader is responsible for calling committee meetings, sending out the agenda
184 in a timely manner, and filling the agenda with engaging and exciting topics. The AU representative serves
185 as the vice-leader of the committee, and the leader is also responsible for determining the size and
186 composition of the committee.

213 **Purpose:**
214 Allocate welfare funds to clubs and associations at NMBU.

215
216 **Background:**
217 Once per semester, the Student Parliament allocate welfare funds to organizations and associations
218 connected to NMBU. This year, a total of **NOK 696,467** will be allocated, of which **92% (NOK 640,750)**
219 will be distributed at ST2 (see attachment: Overview of Funds 2026).

220
221 The distribution of welfare funds is regulated by the “**Regulations for Allocation of Welfare Funds**”,
222 adopted at ST2 2024. The Committee for Allocation of Welfare Funds has used these regulations to

223 propose a distribution of funds for this semester (see attachments 2 and 3). The committee has consisted
224 of the following members:

- 225 • Welfare Funds Responsible in the Executive Committee (AU): Ronja Isaksen Daniloff
- 226 • One additional representative from AU: Frida Reier Rushfeldt
- 227 • Financial Officer in the Samfunnet Board: Ola Reinskou Andersen
- 228 • A student representative on the SiÅs Board: Sverre Johan Bakke Dahl
- 229 • A person with previous experience from the allocation process: Oskar Solberg Lægland
- 230 • Representative elected by the Student Parliament: William Fredrik Bakke Dahl
- 231 • Representative elected by the Student Parliament: Theo Mølster

232 The support from the welfare funds is divided into three categories:

- 233 • **Basic support** (general operational support for associations)
- 234 • **Start-up support** (additional support for newly established associations)
- 235 • **Activity funds** (support for individual activities, following application with budget)

236
237 Attachment 2, "*Proposal for Distribution of Welfare Funds*", shows the committee's full recommendation
238 for the distribution of all funds, while attachment 3, "*Proposal for Distribution of Activity Funds*", shows
239 which associations and activities we propose to allocate activity funds to.

240
241 A total of **63 applications** were received, amounting to **NOK 829,611**. Since only **NOK 640,750** is
242 available for allocation this time, including basic support, the committee has been required to prioritize.
243 In addition to the rules in the regulations, the committee has used the following guidelines when
244 assessing applications:

- 245 • Applicants with **Open Association** status were prioritized.
- 246 • Applicants who submitted strong applications, as well as clear documentation and accounts for last
247 year's allocated funds, were prioritized.
- 248 • Applicants who attended the **welfare funds workshop** were prioritized.
- 249 • Maximum **NOK 5,000** for annual meetings/general assemblies.
- 250 • Maximum **NOK 3,500** for cabin trips (NMBU cabins).
- 251 • Activities related to **Fadderuka** and August in general were deprioritized.
- 252 • **Vors** and **info-vors** have not been granted funds.
- 253 • **Christmas dinners** are reserved for line associations and open associations and may receive a
254 maximum of **NOK 6,000**.
- 255 • Funds for **information evenings, stands/recruitment** have been deprioritized.
- 256 • Associations with more than **NOK 100,000** in assets were deprioritized for activity funds.
- 257 • Applicants without **approved ethical guidelines** have not received support this year.

258

365 **Purpose:**

366 To review and update a previously adopted resolution, now including the amendments adopted at
367 Student Parliament Meeting 1, as well as some rewriting to align the text with the adopted changes.

368
369 **Background:**

370 The Student Board has reviewed older and outdated resolutions from the Student Parliament. In this
371 process, we have identified several resolutions that are still relevant and should therefore be brought
372 back to the Student Parliament.

373
374 The Vego Standard Resolution from 2019 is considered still relevant. The Student Board therefore wishes
375 for the Student Parliament to assess whether it should be re-adopted. The resolution has been updated
376 to reflect the current situation and ensure that the content is up to date.

439 distributed monthly by the Inclusion Funds Committee to activities that seek to bring together
440 international and Norwegian students here at NMBU. The rules for the Student Parliament's Inclusion
441 Funds are revised by the Student Parliament every even-numbered year. The revision shall be discussed
442 at ST-1 and potentially adopted at ST-2. The proposed amendments in the document were written by the
443 chair of the Inclusion Funds Committee, based on comments from the committee and the discussion item
444 at ST-1.

549 Discuss how the Student Parliament believes NMBU and our ELSA representatives should relate to HUJI
550 (the Hebrew University of Jerusalem) and its membership in the ELLS alliance.

552 **Background:**

553 NMBU is a member of the EuroLeague for Life Sciences alliance (ELLS), and two student representatives
554 from NMBU are also represented in the ELLS Student Association (ELSA). ELLS has 10 member
555 universities and two partner universities, of which one is the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in Israel
556 (HUJI).

557 In light of Israel's invasion of Gaza in 2023, and HUJI's connection to the Israeli military (IDF), students
558 from other ELLS universities have raised questions about HUJI's membership status in the ELLS alliance.
559 (See attachment x for additional information.) At present, NMBU has not taken a strong stance on this
560 matter. NMBU's ELSA representatives wish to know how the Student Democracy wants both us and
561 NMBU to position ourselves regarding HUJI's membership in the ELLS network.

564 1. Does the Student Democracy want NMBU to take an active position within ELLS against HUJI
565 continuing as a member of the alliance? / Does the Student Democracy want NMBU to take an

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624 **Resolution – Equalization of vegetarian and meat dishes at NMBU.**

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Adopted at Student Parliament Meeting xxxxxxxx

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Norwegian meat consumption has more than doubled between 1959 and 2021. At the same time as agriculture has become increasingly industrialised, climate change is causing more extreme weather, the polar ice is melting, sea levels are rising, crops are drying out, and species are going extinct faster than ever before. We are experiencing a climate crisis and are on track to exceed the 1.5-degree target. Reduced meat consumption alone will not save the planet, but it will be an important contribution.

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NMBU has a strong focus on climate. As Norway's sustainability university, we should take the lead in creating a more climate-friendly university and college sector, including when it comes to food services. Equal treatment of vegetarian and meat-based food will be a natural way to show that we as a university take the climate crisis seriously and promote sustainability in action — not just in words.

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In practice, this means that dishes with meat and dishes without meat are treated equally. When ordering food for an event, the selection must be 50/50 plant-based and meat-based — unless all participants specify what they want. This is instead of treating requests for meat-free food as a special preference similar to allergies, as is currently the case.

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The Student Parliament wants:

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- NMBU to introduce equal treatment of vegetarian and meat-based food at all events where food is served.
- Local ingredients to be prioritised whenever possible.
- NMBU and SiÅs to improve the quality of vegetarian food so that nutritious, high-quality meals are served.
- To lead by example by introducing equal treatment of vegetarian and meat-based food within the Student Parliament itself.

678 The inclusion funds' main objective is to promote the inclusion of international students in the student
679 environment at NMBU. The inclusion funds contribute to this by creating contact between Norwegian

683 **Both individual students, All groups and associations from NMBU can apply for funding, including**

689 **The deadline for application is the 5th every month. The deadline for application is the 15th every**
690 **month.** Should the set deadline fall on a holiday or weekend, the deadline will be the first working day
691 after the holiday or weekend. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be processed **until the**
692 **following month.** The applications will be proceeded by the inclusion funds comitee, and the **funds will**
693 **be transferred** the response to the application will be received **within the 15th 25^h every month.** All
694 grantings of the iclusion funds will be public. This includes which association, planned activity, and the
695 amount of funds granted.

696 **1.2 Application:**

697 **If you have any questions about the application process, contact the international officer in the Student**

 713 • The applicant must seek to make as many students as possible benefit from the activities for which it is
 714 applying.
 715 • Activities on or close to campus have a higher priority in the distribution of funds. However, activities
 716 organized further away where the target is cultural/language exchange may still qualify for funding.
 717 • Activities that are free for participants are given higher priority in the distribution of funds. Entry fees
 718 are only permitted when justified and must be reasonable, non-exclusionary, and limited to covering
 719 additional costs directly related to the specific event.
 720 • Closed or internal activities may be considered as long as the target is cultural/language exchange.
 721 • Only upcoming events can be applied for. Exceptions can be made by the committee under special
 722 circumstances.
 723 • Applicants who also receive Inclusion Funds, support from Studentsamfunnet i Ås or other funds for
 724 their activity may still be eligible for funding, however, the amount may be reduced.
 725 • On special dates (Like Halloween, Christmas eve, New Years Eve, 17th of May) events may still receive
 726 funding even when colliding with other including events.

1.4 Not eligible for support:

4 Reimbursement of Funds:

776 The International Officer in the Student Board has the authority to issue warnings and demand refunds
777 as sanctions. Application of warnings and sanctions must be notified to the Inclusion Funds committee.

780 Applicants that fail to refund unused funds within 2 months after the planned activity, will not receive

783 Groups and associations expressing discrimination based on gender, ethnicity, religion, belief, disability,
784 sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression in their statements and/or actions will not be

991 Other activities that overlap with events and days planned for the Buddy week will not be granted
992 inclusions funds.

993 Criteria:

994 An application including all activities planned for the Buddy week must be submitted following the same
995 criteria as the rest of the inclusion funds.

996 The Introduction Week is exempt from the rules regarding applications for redistribution between events
997 within the Introduction Week for minor cost changes. Any redistribution must still be documented in the
998 report. A report must be submitted following the same criteria as the rest of the inclusion funds.
999

1000 **8. Revision of the Rules:**

1001 The regulations are revised by the Student Parliament every even-numbered year. Revision of
1002 regulations is a matter for discussion at ST-1 and a matter for decision at ST-2. The new version is put
1003 into use rights after it has been adopted by the Student Parliament.

1289 **Background to discussion case- HUJIs membership in the ELLS alliance**

1290

1291 **What are ELLS and ELSA?**

1292 The EuroLeague for Life Sciences (ELLS) is an alliance of European universities committed to life sciences
1293 for sustainability. Rooted in scientific excellence and societal engagement, ELLS drives the
1294 transformation of agri-food systems through collaboration in education, research, and innovation. ELLS
1295 has ten member universities in Europe, including NMBU, and two partner universities outside of Europe:
1296 Lincoln University in New Zealand and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in Israel (HUJI).

1297

1298 The ELLS Student Association (ELSA) is made up of two representatives from each member university
1299 (with voting rights) and one observing representative from partner universities. The primary aim of the
1300 ELSA group is to ensure that the student voice is included in decisions made by ELLS and to raise student
1301 issues through the appropriate channels. At present there are representatives in ELSA from all
1302 universities except HUJI.

1303

1304 **What is the situation?**

1305 Given the invasion of Gaza by the state of Israel, concern has been raised by students from ELLS
1306 universities that a collaboration with HUJI is problematic and unethical. Many also recognize that not all
1307 students or faculties may agree with the views of their government or the actions of their national
1308 military, thus collaboration with individuals is not necessarily in question. However, there are concerns
1309 about this institutional-level collaboration as HUJI is a public university with ties to the national military,
1310 the Israeli Defense Force (IDF).

1311

1312 **How does HUJI engage in ELLS and by extension with NMBU?**

1313 The Hebrew University of Jerusalem (HUJI) is currently a partner university of the ELLS Alliance. HUJI is
1314 an Israeli public research university based in Jerusalem. As a partner university, HUJI pays for
1315 membership into ELLS. Students from HUJI are able to study abroad at ELLS universities (including
1316 NMBU), enroll in ELLS summer schools, and participate in ELLS conferences. It also opens opportunities
1317 for faculty mobility and joint research. As of now, it appears participation of HUJI is minimal, with a few
1318 students participating in exchanges and conferences, but at this time, we do not have further concrete
1319 statistics.

1320

1321 **Why might this affiliation pose an ethical dilemma?**

1322 Part of HUJI's campus is built on occupied Palestinian territory. HUJI hosts an Israeli Defense Force (IDF,
1323 national military) training programme and has promoted its provision of logistical equipment to military
1324 units after the invasion of Gaza began in 2023. The chairman of the largest Israeli arms manufacturer sits
1325 on HUJI's Board of Trustees.

1326

1327 Several universities have cut ties with HUJI to date, and in 2025, both the Erasmus University Rotterdam
1328 (EUR) and Maastricht University, both in the Netherlands, assessed the ethics of collaborating with HUJI.
1329 EUR found that:

1330

1331 "Overall, the committee considers that there are credible indications of Hebrew University's involvement
1332 in structural violations of human rights and/or international humanitarian law (including war crimes),
1333 directly with respect to its physical presence in Occupied Palestinian Territory (especially on land
1334 acquired since the Occupation in 1967) and indirectly with respect to its structural entanglement with
1335 the State of Israel and the IDF through its military programmes. Under these circumstances, collaboration
1336 with Hebrew University puts the EUR in a position in which it may become indirectly connected to these

1337 violations, which would in turn seriously compromise the fundamental values and academic
1338 responsibilities of the EUR.”

1339

1345 **How has ELLS discussed this to date?**

1346 As student representatives in ELLS, we have little insight into the discussions on this. Our sense is that
1347 there is reluctance in ELLS to take any action and rather to keep engagement at low levels. No public
1348 statements have been made and no official positions have been taken to our knowledge.

1349
1350 In 2025, ELLS skirted on making the decision on whether HUJI students should be allowed to participate
1351 in the annual Student Scientific Conference and placed it on the host university in Sweden, Svensk
1352 Landbruks University (SLU). As a public institution, SLU opted to follow the national guidelines and allow
1353 HUJI students to participate.

1388 Rules for Inclusion Funds

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 1390 **Rules for Inclusion funds**

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Latest revision Student Parliament 2, 16.03.2026

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1407

Objectives:

1409 The inclusion funds' main objective is to promote the inclusion of international students in the student
 1410 environment at NMBU. The inclusion funds contribute to this by creating contact between Norwegian
 1411 and International students, and to give International and Norwegian students an arena to share
 1412 knowledge involving culture, language, and history.

1413

Who can apply?

1415 All groups and associations from NMBU can apply for funding, including Studentsamfunnet I Ås.
 1416 Individual students can also apply for funding, but organizations are prioritized.

1417

1. The application process:
1.1 Deadline and process:

1420 **The deadline for application is the 15th every month.** Should the set deadline fall on a holiday or
 1421 weekend, the deadline will be the first working day after the holiday or weekend. Applications submitted
 1422 after the deadline will not be processed until the following month. The applications will be proceeded by
 1423 the inclusion funds comitee, and the response to the application will be received within the 25^h every
 1424 month. All grantings of the iclusion funds will be public. This includes which association, planned activity,
 1425 and the amount of funds granted.

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1.2 Application:

1429 If you have any questions about the application process, contact the international officer in the Student
 1430 Board.

- 1431 • An application has to be sent through Nettskjema on Studentdemokratiet/ressurser-midler. The
- 1432 International Officer is responsible for the application form.
- 1433 • Decisions made by the committee are final and cannot be appealed.

- 1434 • Applications will not be processed in July.
- 1435 • The applicant must advertise the activities in both English AND Norwegian.
- 1436 • Applicants must advertise and report on how they marketed in order to receive funding.
- 1437 • Students applying for larger social/pro-active activities will be prioritized
- 1438 • The committee of Inclusion Funds will take into account the number of applicants and assess
- 1439 according to what activities that they believe will facilitate the most cultural exchange between
- 1440 Norwegians and Internationals.

1441
1442
1443 **1.3 Requirements for the applicant and the application:**

- 1444 • The funds must be used for socio-cultural activities.
- 1445 • The application and the report must be written in English.
- 1446 • For organizations applying: Use the bank account that belongs to the organization, not a private
- 1447 account.
- 1448 • The application must contain a budget with explanations for each post.
- 1449 • The applicant must seek to make as many students as possible benefit from the activities for
- 1450 which it is applying.
- 1451 • Activities on or close to campus have a higher priority in the distribution of funds. However,
- 1452 activities organized further away where the target is cultural/language exchange may still qualify
- 1453 for funding.
- 1454 • Activities that are free for participants are given higher priority in the distribution of funds. Entry
- 1455 fees are only permitted when justified and must be reasonable, non-exclusionary, and limited to
- 1456 covering additional costs directly related to the specific event.
- 1457 • Closed or internal activities may be considered as long as the target is cultural/language
- 1458 exchange.
- 1459 • Only upcoming events can be applied for. Exceptions can be made by the committee under special
- 1460 circumstances.
- 1461 • Applicants who also receive Inclusion Funds, support from Studentsamfunnet i Ås or other funds
- 1462 for their activity may still be eligible for funding, however, the amount may be reduced.
- 1463 • On special dates (Like Halloween, Christmas eve, New Years Eve, 17th of May) events may still
- 1464 receive funding even when colliding with other including events.

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1467 **1.4 Not eligible for support:**

- 1468 • Expenses for tobacco or alcohol
- 1469 • Expenses for activities which are only educational and/or political. These types of activities may
- 1470 be eligible for support through the Funds for Academic and Political Activities
- 1471 • Expenses for fieldwork or other thesis work
- 1472 • Transportation expenses
- 1473 • Activities with aim to collect money for your or other organizations.

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1476 **2 Report:**

- 1477 • A report with all the receipts has to be submitted through Nettskjema no later than 1 month after
- 1478 the activity has taken place.
- 1479 • A report should include an explanation about
 - 1480 o how the event went
 - 1481 o how many people came, both internationals and Norwegians
 - 1482 o how you marketed the event
 - 1483 o Accounting overview: how much money you got, how much was spent and what the expenses
 - 1484 were, and surplus if you did have less expenses that budgeted for. (including receipts)

- 1485 • Any potential redistribution of funds must be explained in both the report and the accounting
1486 overview.
1487 •

1488 **3 Redistribution of funds:**

1489 If you have other expenses than you originally planned for, or if you have to change the original event due
1490 to unforeseen circumstances, then you can apply for redistribution through Nettskjema. The
1491 international officer is responsible for processing the applications for redistribution of funds.

1492 The application for redistribution must include:

- 1493 • Why you have the surplus.
1494 • From which activity are you redistributing money from.
1495 • Description of the new activity or expense that you are planning, including when it will take place.
1496 • Budget for the new activity or expense.
1497 • Other demands:
1498 • The redistribution must be explained clearly in the report after the events.
1499 • The redistributed funds must be used within a month of the approved distribution.
1500 • Redistributed funds that are not used must be reimbursed.
1501

1502 **4 Reimbursement of Funds:**

1503 • All funds not spent must be reimbursed within 1 month of the event to account **1654.20.29092**. Include
1504 organization name, mark it with "**Project 112 inclusion funds [name of organization]**", and notify the
1505 International Officer about the transfer.

1506 • Applicants who fail to refund unused Inclusion funds within the deadline will not receive new funds
1507 until the unused funds are reimbursed.
1508

1510 **5 Violation of guidelines:**

1511 If the applicant fails to comply with the rules of this document or organization if funds are used for
1512 purposes not supported by inclusion funds, it may result in sanctions for the person, group or
1513 organization that is applying.

1514 The mildest form of sanction is a warning, while the strictest is exclusion from the allocations for the next
1515 year.
1516

1517 The International Officer in the Student Board has the authority to issue warnings and demand refunds
1518 as sanctions. Application of warnings and sanctions must be notified to the Inclusion Funds committee.
1519 If the case is of higher severity, it will be referred to the Student Parliament and treated as a complaint
1520 case there.

1521 Applicants that fail to refund unused funds within 2 months after the planned activity will not receive
1522 new funds until the unused funds are refunded. For more information on refunds, see subsection 4.
1523 Reimbursement of Funds
1524

1525 Groups and associations expressing discrimination based on gender, ethnicity, religion, belief, disability,
1526 sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression in their statements and/or actions will not be
1527 eligible to receive inclusion funds. Exceptions to this apply to special arrangements where discrimination
1528 serves a legitimate purpose, such as gender-specific associations or local associations.

1529 If violations of the inclusion funds guidelines are discovered, a complaint can be filed. All students at
1530 NMBU can file a complaint which is submitted to the Student Board.

6 The Inclusion Funds Committee:

- One representative from the Student Board (leader of the committee)
- One representative from the Samfunnet Board
- One representative from ISU
- One representative from ESN
- 2 representatives from Student parliament

If necessary, AU can supplement with an extra member to be capable of passing decisions

Committee members who themselves are board members of the organizations applying for funding or are actively involved in planning the event will not be allowed to participate or be present in the processing of the application. This includes the general discussions and outcome of the application.

There should be at least 3 committee members present in order to make decisions concerning applications.

7. Introduction week:

Introduction week is referred to as the introductory, or welcome activities organized to welcome the new arriving international students.

The Buddy General in cooperation with ESN and ISU are the main responsible for the planning and execution of the Introduction week in both August and January/February. The Inclusion Funds also provide financial support for the Introduction week during both periods. The activities planned for the incoming international student are exempt from the requirement of mandatory inclusion of Norwegian students.

Other activities that overlap with events and days planned for the Buddy week will not be granted inclusions funds.

Criteria:

An application including all activities planned for the Buddy week must be submitted following the same criteria as the rest of the inclusion funds.

The Introduction Week is exempt from the rules regarding applications for redistribution between events within the Introduction Week for minor cost changes. Any redistribution must still be documented in the report.

- A report must be submitted following the same criteria as the rest of the inclusion funds.

8 Revision of the Rules:

The regulations are revised by the Student Parliament every even-numbered year. Revision of regulations is a matter for discussion at ST-1 and a matter for decision at ST-2. The new version is put into use rights after it has been adopted by the S
